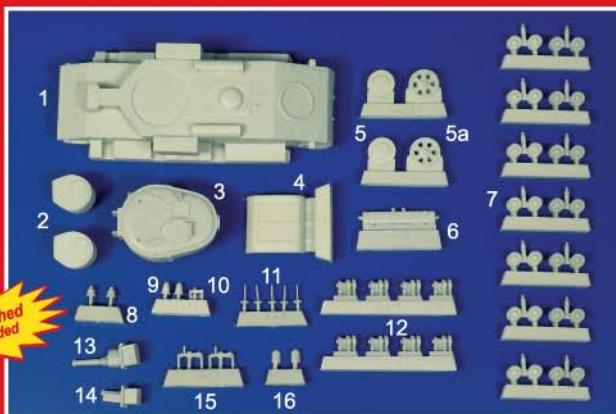

Please carefully read these step-by-step instructions
before assembling the tracks.

Tightly clamp the track
in a bending tool as shown.



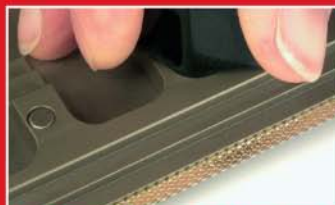
Use a fine pointy object such as a toothpick
to carefully bend the teeth outward.



Use a metal straight edge
to press the teeth into a 90 degree angle.



Carefully bend the lengths of track
using a bending tool.



Tightly crimp the track with the bending tool.



After bending apply liquid flux
between the two halves of the track.



Bond the two halves using a small amount
of solder in order not to lose any fine detail.



Underside of hull
with idler and road wheels attached.



Track No. 1
Track No. 2 opposite side

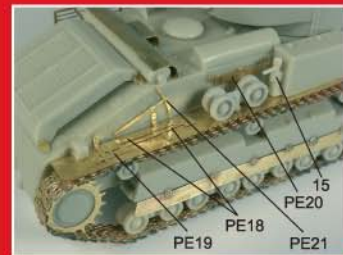
Carefully bend the lengths of track
around the running gear.



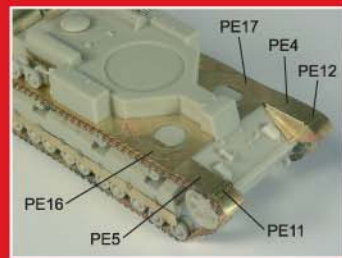
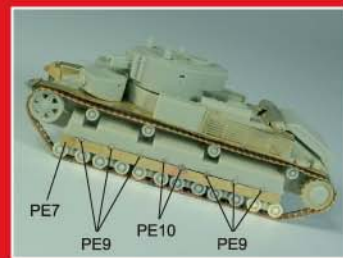
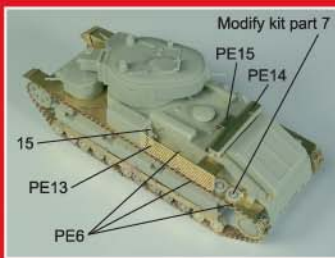
One or two of the track links might need to
be removed before gluing the ends of track.



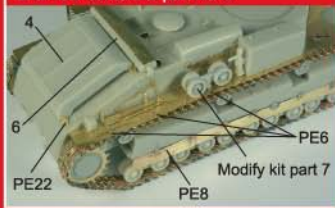
Hull with running gear and track attached.
